


There's no doubt that technology can wow us – but many struggle with the increasingly complex terminology, according to new research by Samsung...




55% of us are excited by new technology

Map apps were revealed to be the app which Europeans feel have had the biggest impact on them in terms of making their lives easier – something noted by **66%**. This was followed by weather apps (**56%**) and phone cameras (**51%**)
