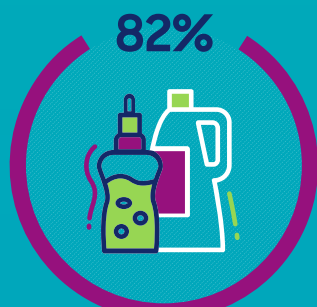

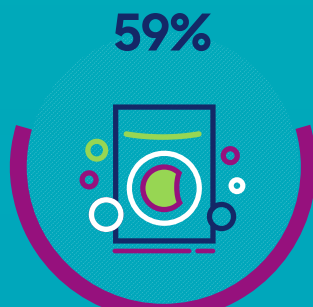

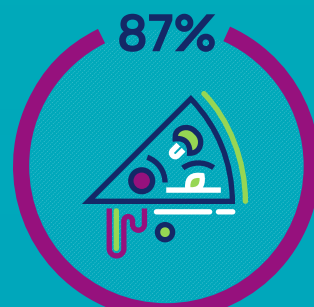

making a mess and not cleaning up



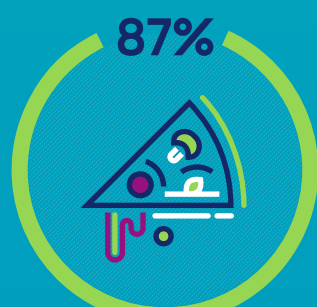

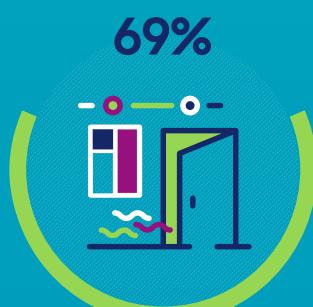

leaving out of date / rotting food in the fridge



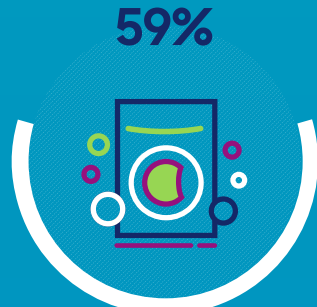
not shutting the door properly so everything inside warms to room temperature



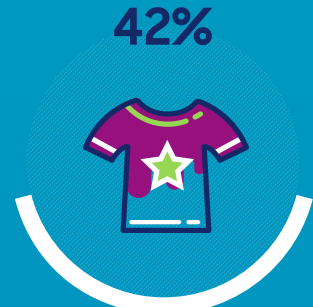
wasting fridge space by not stacking things correctly

not emptying pockets before going in the wash



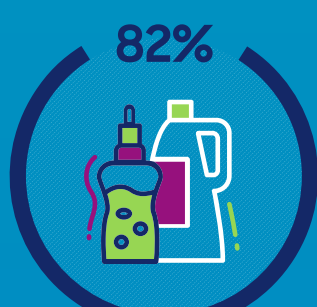
ruining white/lighter clothes by putting them in the wash with darks



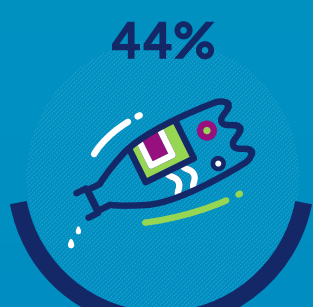
forgetting about/ leaving washed laundry in the machine



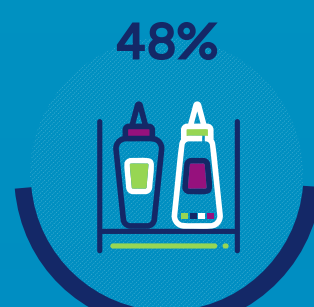
our worst frustrations in the kitchen



making a mess and not cleaning up



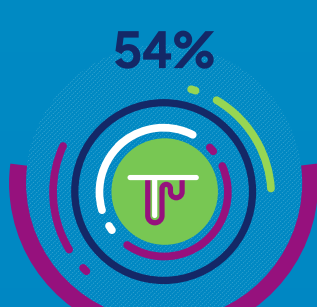
finishing a bottle / carton and placing it empty back in the fridge



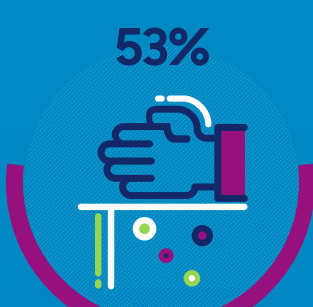
not putting ingredients back in the cupboard



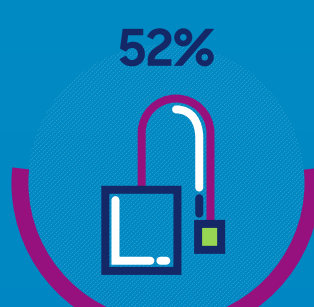
kitchen cleanliness frustrations

THE



FRIDGE

The fridge came out top at **41%** followed by the washing machine **21%**, whilst the kettle and oven tied at **16%**



One of the biggest frustrations we can have is how to make the perfect cup of tea. But Samsung can reveal the perfect formula

Step one:

89% say to boil the kettle for the full time

Step two:

49% say brew for 3-5 minutes with **46%** saying 1-2, with **1%** saying over 8 minutes

Step three:

81% say always add milk after the hot water is added

Step four:

41% tea should end up the colour of caramel with only **14%** milky
