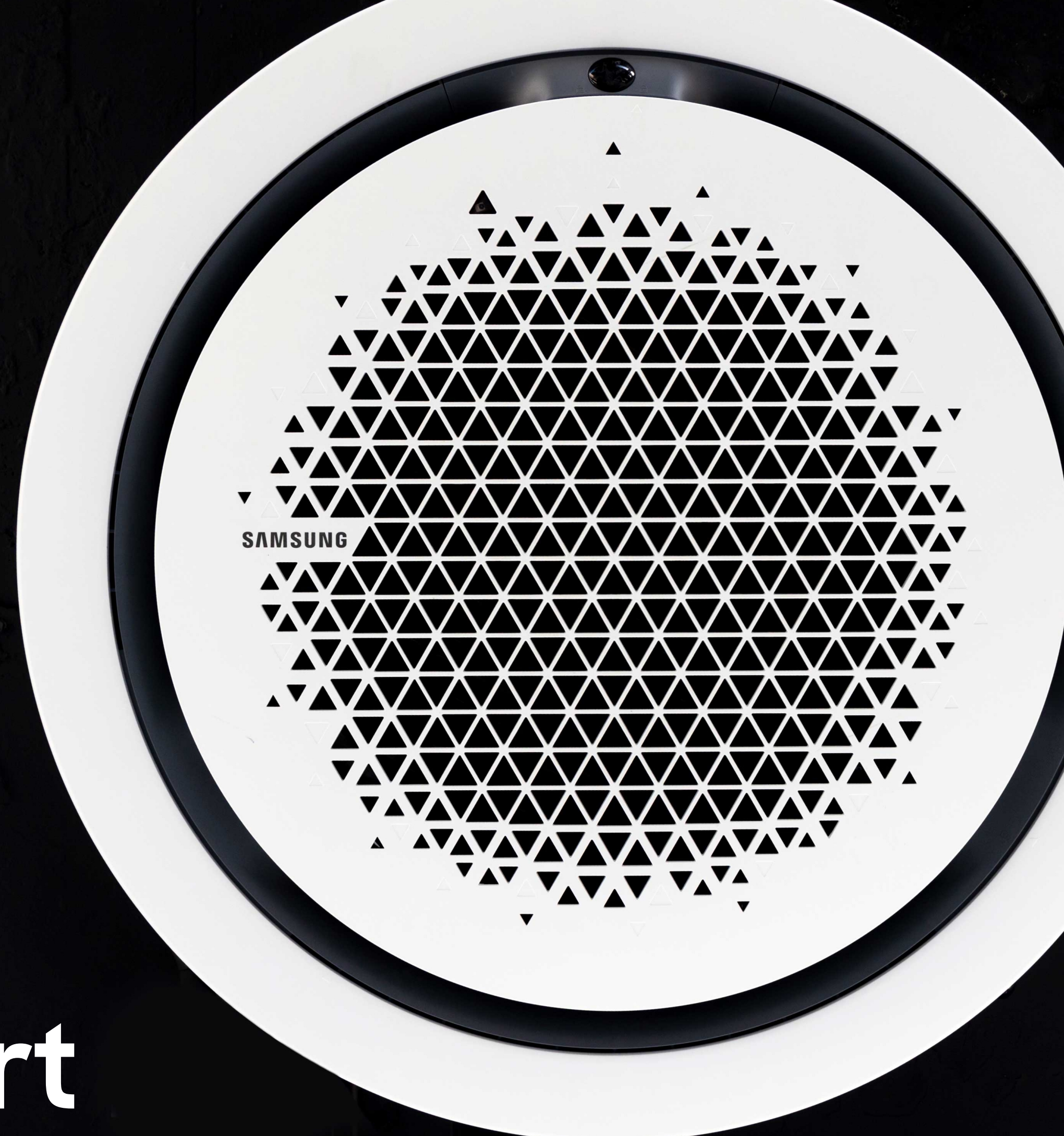


Research Reveals* UK Hybrid Worker Habits Are Increasingly Motivated By Temperatures And The Comfort Of Office Conditions



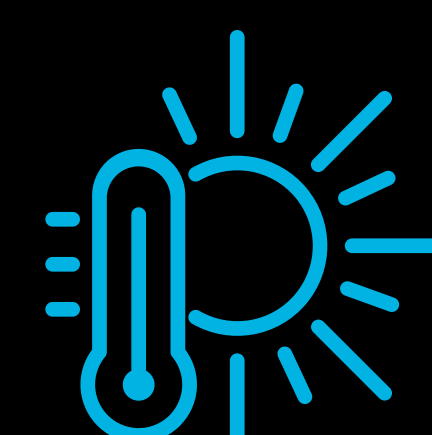
**Almost two-thirds

or was low quality



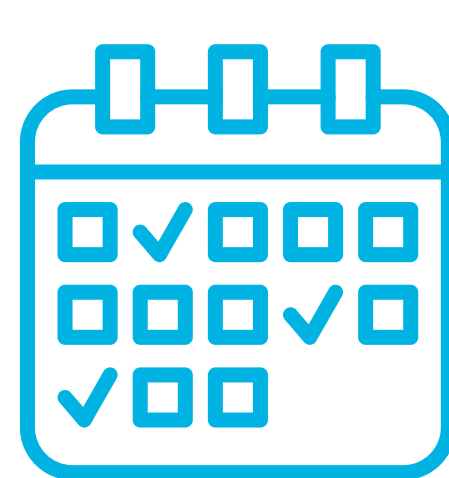
**Close to half

9.2

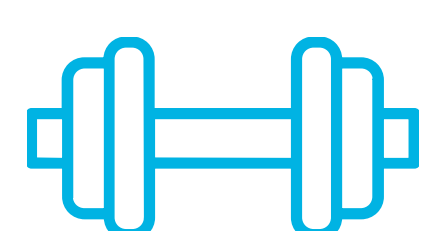

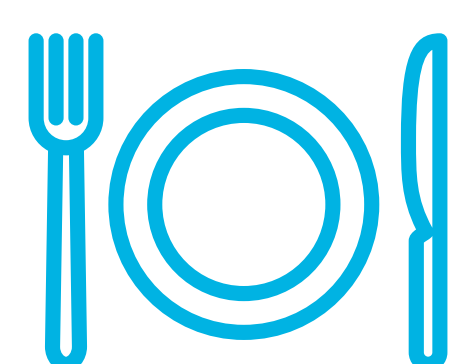

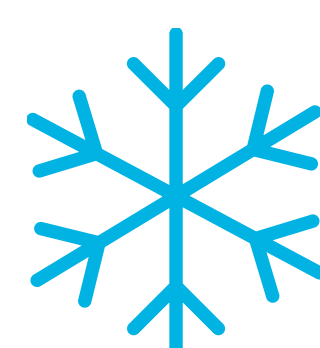

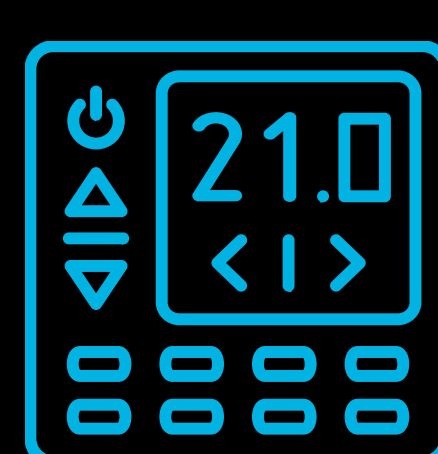
